ENDOWMENT INTEREST NEWS (Tenth Edition)

Q: What happens to the money that is donated to the Endowment Fund.

R: The money is combined with all other money designated by the donors to be placed in the Endowment Fund. The combined money, the Endowment fund principle, is permanently retained by the church and invested to produce income. The income can then be distributed for the purposes intended by the Bylaws; however, the principle can not be distributed and must be retained to continue producing income. The principle in the Endowment Fund is the permanent gift to the church that keeps on giving as it produces on going income. The larger the Endowment Fund grows the greater

For Your Reading & Reflection

Members and friends of SOV are invited and encouraged to prepare for Sunday worship by reading and reflecting on the scripture readings for the upcoming Sunday in their devotional life at home (or wherever it takes place). Pay special attention to the Gospel text. *Questions for your reflecting:*

- ① *What is capturing my attention in this text?* ② *What questions does the text ask of me?*
